Modal Verbs

Saying what you can and can't do, and what you are allowed to do

Can/could + verb

Modal verbs for ability

You use **can** and **can't** in the present

Examples

- Ali can drive.
- She can't swim
- He can't do the homework. It's difficult.
- She can see the film tomorrow.

Talking about the past

You use **could** and **couldn't** in the past:

Examples:

- I couldn't go shopping yesterday. The shops were closed.
- She could read when she was 5 years old

Modal verbs for permission

Examples

- Can I borrow your pen?
- Could I use your phone?
- You can watch T.V
- You can't go out tonight.

Remember!

When you want to ask for something, you use **can or could**. **Could** is polite. This is not the same as using could for ability in the past
