And, or, but, because, but not

Examples:

I like water **and** juice.

I have milk **but not** sugar in my coffee.

I don't like tea **or** hot chocolate.

Words for connecting parts of sentences together

And adds two things together

She plays basketball **and** football.

I had a shower **and** ate my dinner.

But makes a contrast: _____

He likes horror films **but** he doesn't like action films. = He likes horror films **but not** action films.

Or links two negative things :

I don't like fruit **or** vegetables.

Ben doesn't like pizza **or** rice.

Because shows a reason :

We can't go to the beach **because** it's cold.

I don't want to go running **because** it's dark.

Remember !

You don't need to repeat the subject after **and** and **or**.

I love reading and drawing. (I love reading and I love drawing.)

I don't like football or cricket. (I don't like football or I don't like cricket.)
