Present Simple :

Negative and Questions

Talking about habits and situations that don't change

Don't / doesn't + verb | do / does + verb ?

Verbs for talking about habits and situations that don't change

We use the present simple

. for things that are always true:

My name is Jamil. I come from Morocco.

The sky is blue.

. for facts about your life:

I work in a shop.

Ahmad lives in an apartment.

. to talk about habits :

You can use **never, sometimes, often, usually, always, every day, at the weekend**

I **never go** swimming. I **often have** sandwiches for lunch. Steven **plays** tennis **every weekend**.

EXAMPLES:

PRESENT SIMPLE

Positive -

I live in Pakistan.

You live in Pakistan.

He / she / it lives in Pakistan.

We live in Pakistan.

They live in Pakistan.

NEGATIVE

I don't eat fish.

You don't eat fish.

He / she / it doesn't eat fish.

We don't eat fish.

They don't eat fish.

QUESTIONS

Do I like rice?

Do you like rice?

Does he / she it like rice?

Do we like rice?

Do they like rice?

SHORT ANSWERS

Yes, I do. No, I don't.

Yes, you do. No, you don't.

Yes, he / she /does. No, he / she doesn't.

Yes, we do. No, we don't.

Yes, they do. No, they don't.

REMEMBER!

For **he, she and it**, add **-s** to the verb: I **work**, you **work**, he / she / it **works**, we **work**, they **work**.

We use **does/ doesn't** in negatives, questions and short answers.

The verb **have** : I **have**, you **have**, he / she it **has**, we **have**.
