# The Inner Solar System

The inner solar system is the name of the terrestrial planets and asteroid belt. Terrestrial is just a fancy way of saying rocky. Like the Earth, terrestrial planets have a core of iron and rock.

At the center of the solar system is the Sun The Sun is a big ball of hydrogen powered by nuclear reactions. Massive explosions are going and of the time inside the Sun. Next to us in is Mars. Mars also has a core of rock and iron. It is a little more than half the size of Earth. The most distinct feature about Mars is Its red color. Dust rich in in oxide covers the planet. It's sort of like the planet is rusting. White caps at the poles are water, forever frozen because of the colder temperatures further from the Sun. The orly place the temperature riess above freezing is at the equator, or the middle of the planet. Mars has two moons. Delimos and Phobos but they are much smaller than our own moon. It lakes nearly twice as long for Mars to circle the sun at almost 884 days.
